School & Community

Faith Academy is a private, Christian school, grades K-12, which is now in its twenty-first year of operation. Faith Academy strives to prepare students to be successful in college-level studies by providing them with a rigorous academic background and opportunities to develop independent study skills, work ethic, and study habits critical to college success.

Faith Academy is a certified University-Model® school. Much like schools that operate using alternate block schedule, students at Faith Academy attend classes three days each week. Most courses are completed in two semesters and receive six credits, three credits per semester. Each semester is sixteen weeks.

The teaching faculty has 51 members. The maximum student-teacher ratio is 20:1 for all secondary classes. The 2020-2021 year finished with 251 students (93 high school, 60 junior high and 98 K-5th grade). Due to small class size, only students in the Top 10% are ranked for automatic admissions.

The Marble Falls community is located in the Highland Lakes area, about 50 miles west of Austin. Students at Faith Academy represent seventeen different zip codes.

Faith Academy is accredited through AdvancED and certified through University-Model® Schools International (UMSI).

The school year is divided into two sixteen week semesters, Fall (August-December), and Spring (January-May). All classes are 55 minutes and meet three days per week. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, from March through the last day of school, classes continued through our online platform, Canvas, with very little disruption. Our grading policies did not change.

Courses include: English I-IV; D.C. English; Algebra I and II; Geometry; Business Pre-Cal; Pre-Calculus; AP Calculus; Biology; Chemistry; Physics; Honors Physics I; Anatomy and Physiology; Honors Biology II and Honors Physics II; D.C. Psychology; World History and Geography I; World History and Geography II; U.S. History; D.C. U.S. History; Government; Economics; Honors Government; Honors Economics; Spanish I, II; Honors Spanish III; French I-III; Sign Language I-III Technology I; Honors Programming I; Multimedia II; Art I-IV; Speech; miscellaneous electives; and athletics (cross country, volleyball, football, basketball, tennis, track and field, baseball, softball, swim and golf). All

courses are considered to be college-preparatory rigor. AP courses are weighted by an additional 10 points (on a 100 point scale) and 1 point (on a 4.0 scale). Dual Credit and Honors courses are weighted by an additional 5 points (on a 100 point scale) and 0.5 point (on a 4.0 scale).

Six Faith Academy hours are usually equivalent to one credit (three hours per class per semester) at a typical high school.

Courses are graded on a scale of 0-100 (exception: athletics and aid/trainer are graded on a pass/fail basis). The course grade represents a percentage of content mastery. WP indicates a withdrawal after six weeks with a passing grade. WF indicates withdrawal after six weeks with a failing grade.
