School & Community

Faith Academy is a private, Christian school, grades Kinder Prep-12, which is now in its twenty-sixth year of operation. Faith Academy strives to prepare students to be successful in college-level studies by providing them with a rigorous academic background and opportunities to develop independent study skills, work ethic, and study habits critical to college success.

Faith Academy is a certified University-Model® Much like schools that operate using alternate block schedule, students at Faith Academy attend classes three days each week. Students complete schoolwork at home 2 days per week. Most courses are completed in two semesters and receive six credits, three credits per semester. Each semester is sixteen weeks.

The teaching faculty has 50 members. maximum student-teacher ratio is 20:1 for all secondary classes. The 2024-2025 year finished with 400 students (130 high school, 102 junior high and 168 PK-5th grade). Due to small class size, only students in the Top 10% are ranked for automatic admissions purposes.

The Marble Falls community is located in the Highland Lakes area, about 50 miles west of Austin. Students at Faith Academy represent seventeen different zip codes.

Faith Academy is accredited through AdvancED (Cognia) and certified through National Association of University Model Schools (NAUMS).

The school year is divided into two sixteen week semesters, Fall (August-December), and Spring (January-May). All classes are 55 minutes and meet three days per week. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, from March through the last day of school, May 2021, classes continued through our online platform, Canvas, with very little disruption, grading policies did not change.

All courses are considered to be college-preparatory rigor. AP courses are weighted by an additional 10 points (on a 100 point scale) and 1 point (on a 4.0 scale). Dual Credit and Honors courses are weighted by an additional 5 points (on a 100 point scale) and 0.5 point (on a 4.0 scale).

Courses are graded on a scale of 0-100 (exception: athletics, mascot, aide and trainer are graded on a

pass/fail basis). The course grade represents a percentage of content mastery. WP indicates a withdrawal after six weeks with a passing grade. WF indicates withdrawal after six weeks with a failing grade.

Courses include: English I-IV; D.C. Comp I ⅈ D.C. British Lit I and II; Algebra I and II; Geometry; Business Math; Honors Pre-Calculus; AP Calculus; Biology; Chemistry; Physics; Honors Physics I; Anatomy and Physiology; Honors Biology II and Honors Physics II; D.C. Psychology; World History; World Geography; U.S. History; D.C. U.S. History; Government; Economics; Honors Government; Honors Economics; Spanish I, II; Honors Spanish III; Sign Language I-III; Technology I; Multimedia (Digital Marketing); Art I-IV; Digital Art and Media; Basic Coding I; Drones; Robotics; Speech; D.C. Speech; miscellaneous electives; and athletics (cross country, volleyball, football, basketball, tennis, track and field, baseball, softball, self-defense and golf).
